

Dress Code

To enable students to reach high academic standards, the school has put in place a dress code designed to reduce distractions and competitions. Implementing a simple, flexible, cost-effective dress code promotes student learning and increased academic instruction time.

Personal Hygiene

The personal grooming of students should be in accord with the standards set by the uniform dress code. Students should be clean and neat when at school.

All Students

Shirts:

- Students must wear solid-colored shirts that are RED, WHITE, or NAVY BLUE.
- Shirts must have flip-over collars and sleeves (long or short). (Examples of acceptable shirt styles include: Polos, turtlenecks, button downs, and mock turtlenecks.)
- Shirts must be long enough to remain tucked into bottoms at all times; however, they may not be more than one size larger than the student's actual size.

Sweaters/Fleece:

- Students may wear solid-colored sweaters or fleece shirts that are RED, WHITE, or NAVY BLUE that do not have hoods (with long or short sleeves).
- Sweatshirts, coats, or other types of outerwear may not substitute as a sweater or fleece shirt.

Pants:

- Students must wear solid-colored pants that are NAVY BLUE or KHAKI.
- Pants must be straight-legged with no excess/cargo pockets. (Patch style pockets are acceptable.) Examples of unacceptable pants are denim, Dickies®, bell-bottoms, cargo, nylon (wind suit), zip-off (lower part of the leg detaches from the upper part), baggy style, jogging pants.
- Belts are required. Students must wear plain, solid-colored belts that are red, white, navy blue, black, or brown. Belts may be leather, leather-like, plastic, or cloth. They may not have large buckles, metal studs, decorations, beads, etc.

Shorts, Capri Pants, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers, Dresses:

- During warm weather, students may wear solid-colored shorts that are navy blue or khaki. Students will not be permitted to remain indoors during cooler weather because they have chosen to wear shorts.
- Girls may wear solid-colored skirts, skorts, jumpers, capri pants, and dresses that are navy blue or khaki. These items must be longer than the student's fingertips when her arms hang straight at her sides. Students will not be permitted to remain indoors during cooler weather because they have chosen to wear bottoms other than pants. Because playground equipment is above ground level, girls should wear modest shorts under skirts, jumpers, and dresses.

Shoes/Boots:

- Shoes should be clean and in good repair without lights, wheels, music, etc.
- Platform shoes (i.e., soles higher than one inch), open-toe/back shoes are not permitted.
- Laces must be tied and Velcro must be closed at all times.
- Boots may be worn only as outdoor footwear.

- Students must wear socks (or tights for girls) at all times. (Socks must be red, white, blue, brown, or black. Thigh-highs, decorative socks/tights, footless tights/ leggings are not permitted.

Hats/Hair:

- Hats may be worn only to and from school for protection from the weather. Hats may be worn inside the building only for Special Days.
- Bandanas, scarves, and other similar items are not permitted.
- Hair must be clean, neat, and of natural colors.

Jewelry:

- Jewelry is not permitted at school except stud earrings and wristwatches.
- Rings, bracelets, and necklaces may not be worn during regular school hours.
- Earrings may not be larger than this size: ●.
